SIMPLE MONTHLY INSIGHTS TO HELP INSPIRE YOUR READING SESSIONS.

CORRECTING READING ERRORS

Regular Words

Words that sound out

Ex: map, tip, can

- 1) Have student sound out the word. If student is unable to, you say the word, and have them repeat it.
- 2) Have student say the word fast.
- 3) Have student start the sentence from the beginning.

Irregular Words:

Words that do not sound out

Ex: circle, to, round

- 1) Stop student and tell them the word.
- 2) Have student touch and say the word.
- 3) Have student say the word fast.
- 4) Have student start the sentence from the beginning.

It is important to be consistent with the correction process and to make sure the correction sticks.
