Jenné Myers, Executive Director of Working in the Schools (WITS), recently announced the appointment of Jeremy Cole, Jennifer Mikulina, and Mark Spender to its Board of Directors.

Jeremy Cole joins WITS as an Associate of Jones Day. Cole played an instrumental role in forming the partnership between WITS and Jones Day, which now sends volunteers into Manierre School through the Power Lunch program. As far as other pro bono work, he helped obtain political asylum for a Colombian woman who had been persecuted by guerilla groups for her work with children in rural Colombia. Cole received his BA from Kalamazoo College and his JD from University of Notre Dame.
